LEVEL UP 21-Day Reading Plan

DAY 1 | Reading: Isaiah 58:3-14

You honor my fast.

Father thank you for honoring my consecration. I am expecting rewards according to your Word: direction, strength, illumination, renewed health and favor. I praise you for your mercy and grace on my life.

DAY 2 | Reading: Luke 1:49-55; Isa 44:24-26 Restoring power.

I release the reversing, restoring power of covenant partnership into my life. God I thank you that you are:

- ·Restoring all Losses
- ·Raising my Expectation
- ·Lifting my Love Limits
- •Delivering from all Destruction

The power of Christ's resurrection is active and changing my life for the better. I thank you for it. Amen.

DAY 3 I Reading: Ephesians 1:17-23 The power of Christ.

I thank you for increasing understanding of your power, your covenant favor toward us, and the authority that Christ has in the earth. *All things are under his feet.* I can live in victory.

DAY 4 | Reading: Ephesians 6:10-11 GNB You strengthen me.

I will be strengthened by the power of God, to stand against all hindrances or barriers of life. I will have the power to live victorious.

DAY 5 | Reading: Jeremiah 33:3

You answer me.

I am ready to receive marvelous messages from you – that will change my life, reverse situations and energize me in your purpose.



Core Scriptures

Luke 1:49-55 MSG

(49)the God whose very name is holy, set apart from all others. (50) His mercy flows in wave after wave on those who are in awe before him. (51) He bared his arm and showed his strength, scattered the bluffing braggarts. (52)He knocked tyrants off their high horses, pulled victims out of the mud. (53) The starving poor sat down to a banquet; the callous rich were left out in the cold. (54) He embraced his chosen child, Israel; he remembered and piled on the mercies, piled them high. (55) It's exactly what he promised, beginning with Abraham and right up to now.

Isaiah 44:24-26 MSG

(24)GOD, your Redeemer, who shaped your life in your mother's womb, says: "I am GOD. I made all that is. With no help from you I spread out the skies and laid out the earth." (25) He makes the magicians look ridiculous and turns fortunetellers into jokes. He makes the experts look trivial and their latest knowledge look silly. (26) But he backs the word of his servant and confirms the counsel of his messengers. He says to Jerusalem, "Be inhabited," and to the cities of Judah, "Be rebuilt," and to the ruins, "I raise you up."

More than just moving up – but metamorphosing up.

DAY 6 I Reading: Jer 32:27; Luke 18:27 Nothing is too hard for You.

Lord, I am prepared to receive what is impossible with men, because all things are possible for you. My life has no limits and your power is active in me for purpose, promise and prosperity.

DAY 7 I Reading: Isaiah 44:24-26 MSG Redeeming power.

You are rebuilding what has been torn down, restoring what has been lost and raising me up to my promised place in you. I thank you — over and over. Amen.

DAY 9 | Reading: Psalm 103:8-18 All my mistakes washed away.

DAY 10 | Reading: Zechariah 9:11-13 Reversal.

- (4) The blessing of Ephraim (Fruitful in difficult places)

DAY 11 | Reading: Zechariah 9; Psalm 112
